Dear MCI Students and Parents/Guardians,

We hope everyone is enjoying this beautiful summer safely and that you are all healthy. While there are many days of summer remaining, we are busy preparing for students' return to campus this fall!

Please find your student's course requests for the 2020-21 school year. Student schedules are not yet ready. Once they are, we will notify you electronically to check your student's course schedule in PowerSchool. Enclosed with the student's course request are options for concurrent enrollment courses and options for full year virtual courses in select subjects, as well as a brief biography of new teachers at MCI.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT APPLICATIONS: these courses are available to juniors and seniors <u>only</u>. Students may gain high school and college credits for the courses in which they enroll. You may reference the list at the end of this letter to verify your course requests. Students MUST email the Dean of Academics for the correct application form in order to complete registration for the college class(es). Students who no longer wish to take a concurrent enrollment course or who would like to change their course requests to include a concurrent enrollment course MUST make the change with the Dean of Academics or their Academic Counselor. Failure to do so may result in incorrect enrollment for the 2020-21 school year and could affect graduation status.

Please remember that any grade earned in a concurrent enrollment course will become part of the student's permanent college transcripts and will be calculated into the student's college GPA. Enrollment is based on course availability at the college, so students must complete the forms ASAP.

**NOTE: there is a tuition charge for college courses for non-MSAD #53 students.

Maine Resident \$94 per credit hour + fees
Non-Resident \$188 per credit hour + fees

VIRTUAL COURSE OFFERINGS: we will be offering full-year virtual courses in select subjects for initial credit. These classes, with the exception of AP4ME courses, are taught by MCI instructors. Students will have access to their teacher online, but they will not have a class scheduled to attend in-person. This opportunity provides students with more flexibility in their class schedules during the academic day while still earning credits toward graduation.

The Academic Office will be available to assist students in course request changes between August 5th to August 14th from 9:00am -2:30pm every day. Students are encouraged to submit their course change requests via email to their counselor or request a video conference to discuss any changes. Students <u>must</u> make an appointment with their counselor to discuss course options in-person. Students and parents must wear face coverings for any in-person meetings, and there is a limit of two people visiting with the counselor at a time.
