In 1995, Ron Antevy and Jonathan Antevy founded *e-Builder*, a South Florida construction

tech company based on a concept from Jon's master's thesis that focused on researching multimedia and internet applications for the construction industry. His vision was to move practical construction applications onto the web. Soon after graduation, Jon partnered with his brother Ron to found *e-Builder*, a web-based construction management solution.

In the early stages of their young company, **Norbert Young, Jr. '66** was instrumental in assisting the Antevys with finding new clients. While President of McGraw-Hill Construction, Norb convinced the corporation to invest \$5 million in *e-Builder*. Over the years, Ron and

Soon after the sale, Ron and Jon reached out to Norb, President of MCI's Board of Trustees, and to Christine with the news of the business being sold. The Antevys offered the Youngs a personal gift of \$180,000 in thanks for all they've done for the brothers over the years.

Norb immediately suggested Ron and Jon make the gift to MCI's Founders Campaign.

"This was the most wonderful surprise," Norb said, explaining how he and Christine learned about the Antevy's gift to MCI's Founders Campaign.
