Dear Parents / Guardians,

MCI is pleased to announce we will be contracting with a Licensed Clinical Social Worker this Fall 2021 to provide school-based outpatient counseling services for our students. <u>Lisa Dezso</u>, LCSW, will be the clinician / provider for this service and will be housed at MCI in a confidential space to meet with students assigned to her caseload.

School-based outpatient counseling is a clinical service that provides treatment for students who have been impacted by or are experiencing; anxiety, depression, parental divorce / seperation, ADHD, bullying, transgender / sexual identity issues, self-injurious behavior / suicidal thoughts, or other mental or behavioral health challenges. After a diagnosis is made, counseling is provided at the school consistent with the student's treatment plan. School-based outpatient counseling requires a referral to initiate services.

As always the MCI Personal Counselor / Social Worker, Macie Batchelder, will still be available for your student throughout the year.
